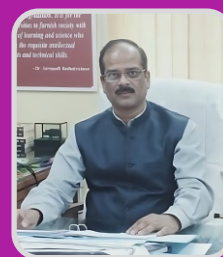

ADMISSION PROCESS (General Instructions)

- I) Admission to the courses offered are given according to the guidelines and rules of Savitribai Phule Pune University, Pune and State Government of Maharashtra on the basis of marks of previous qualifying examination.
- II) For courses B.A., B.Com., B. Voc., B.B.A.(CA), B. Sc. (Comp. Sci.) and B. H. Sc. the students who have qualified XIIth examination will get direct admission.
No merit or entrance test.
- III) For B.Sc. and M.Sc. courses admission will be based on merit list.
- IV) For M.A and M.Com. direct admissions will be given.

Student Academic Card (SAC) Scheme

Each student is issued a Student Academic Card (SAC), a comprehensive record-keeping system that meticulously tracks academic progress, class subjects, and chosen electives. The card is designed in alignment with NEP 2020, the SAC accurately monitors extra credits earned through co-curricular activities, ensuring a transparent and holistic digital profile for every learner. INSTRUCTIONS TO STUDENTS

- A student seeking admission to the college in the first year of undergraduate course and Post Graduate course will have to apply to the college in the prescribed form immediately after the declaration of HSC/SSC examination results/final year degree examination results.
- Application received after the prescribed date for admission will not be considered.
- Student coming from any college affiliated to the University of Savitribai Phule Pune and applying for Second year of B.A/B.Com/B.Sc. can be directly admitted to this college provided the seats are available and if they have good academic record. The student has to apply to the previous college for Transfer Certificate after joining the college.
- Admission will be provisional till the student gets final eligibility certificate from the University.
- Students should be regular and punctual in attending classes, tutorials and submissions of the term work in various subjects. Terms shall not be granted and student shall not be allowed to appear for examination if the academic record and attendance are not satisfactory.
- Any changes in the address of the student must be intimated by them in writing to the college office immediately.
- Students will not be allowed entry in the college premises without valid I-card. College uniform is compulsory.
- A student is expected to read the notices put up on the notice board as well on college website regularly. The college is not responsible for loss of any advantage facility by student due to their failure to read the notices in time.
- In case a student requires to remain absent for some reason, they have to take prior permission of the Principal.
- Any damage to the college property, apparatus, furniture, equipment, library books, building etc. must be paid by the students.
- Students must attend social and national events organized by the college such as 26th January, 15th August and all other event declared national celebrations.
- Students must note all notices displayed on college notice boards.
