BY BUS

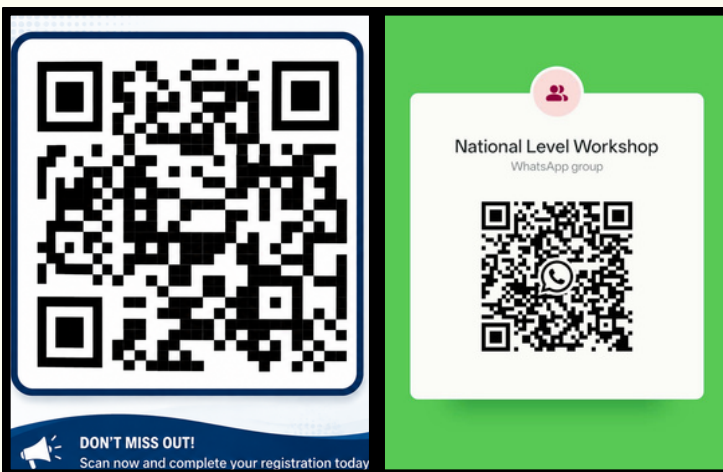
From Pune (Swargate / Pune Station):
